1.5 Story: A residence with two levels of living area with by a steep roof slope and dormers projecting from the roof and generally have windows. The area of the second floor is usually around 40% to 70% of the ground floor area.

1.75 Story: A residence with one full level of living area and a second level that is has a steep roof slope and dormers projecting from the roof and generally have windows on their. The area of the second floor is usually around 75% of the ground floor area.

Protective Covenants: A restrictive covenant is a clause in a deed or lease to real property that limits what the owner of the land or lease can do with the property.
