BPP-Homesnap Incorporation – The Answer You’ve Been Waiting For

Third Party websites (Non-Broker/Agent Sites) have earned a reputation amongst REALTORS®. The mention of some of the more known sites elicit mixed reactions in agents and brokers alike. Some of these sites are notorious for advertising paid agents, excluding listing agents’ information with their own listings, and publishing potentially inaccurate data, misleads the consumer public.

With the intention of alleviating some of the confusion, a group of industry leaders from across the country established a set of guidelines for third-party sites; **The Fair Display Guidelines**. These guidelines indicated how listing data should be displayed; highlighting the broker’s rights to their listings and that leads should be directed to the listing agent. The Fair Display Guidelines also recommended eliminating pairing agent advertisements with another agents’ listing and discouraged charging an agent for their own leads. While this showed progress for the industry, these sites remained the leading source of information to the public. Also, there was no way to enforce these guidelines since the sites are independent companies.

In response to these concerns, with the establishment of the Fair Display Guidelines, a group of likeminded real estate industry leaders created what was known as the **Broker Public Portal (BPP)**. This industry-driven initiative was fully funded by Brokers and MLSs, rather than by advertisements.


A main benefit for REALTORS® was the practice of only displaying listings from the MLS. This prevented the public from being misled by inaccurate data and price estimates. The Broker Public Portal would also only provide leads to the listing agent. This development, referred to as your-listing-your-lead, was what REALTORS® had been waiting for, but they still lacked a platform to accomplish these goals.

Enter Homesnap. The Homesnap app creates a mobile version of the MLS, giving agents full access to the MLS and its data. With agent input, usability is growing to include anticipated features; such as Associated Documents and permission to edit listings and photos. The Homesnap app also allows agents to share the app with their clients. This brands the app to the agent, allowing their clients to exclusively view information from the agent, communicate directly, and easily track data. Within OABR alone, over half the membership uses the app and 13,000+ clients have accepted the agent-branded app invitation. The success and positive feedback of this app nationwide has been profound.

In 2017, BPP officially became Homesnap. While Homesnap had been available to the public for many years, brokers were hesitant to freely provide their listing data to any third-party sites. This caused a lack of data in many markets. Brokers wanted to guarantee all decisions were in the best interest of the public. Now that BPP and Homesnap have joined forces, there is a Board of Directors made up of industry leaders that follow the tenets of The Fair Display Guidelines, ensuring adherence to industry standards.

The reach and usability of Homesnap, combined with the credibility and publicity of BPP, has led to advantages to the public and the real estate industry. Broker Public Portal with Homesnap will continue to transform the way the industry works in a mobile-first world. This incorporation builds a home search experience that encourages agent-to-consumer and agent-to-agent collaboration. Already, it has put the best listing information, largest private marketing network and most successful client communication engagement tool in the palm of the hands of 850,000 agents via its mobile-first platform.



10 Simple Tips to Become a Better Listener

1. Keep in mind: Listening is win/win. We may not listen that well because we think we won't get much out of it personally. The better you listen, the better you will be listened to. Focus on understanding and on giving value based on what you just heard. This reminder has been a powerful motivator for me to become a better listener.

2. Tell yourself you'll tell someone else about this conversation later on. One of the best ways to remember something better is to know that you are going to tell what you learned to someone else. Then you'll be more alert, naturally start asking more questions to understand and what is said – in my experience – simply seems to stick better.

3. Keep the eye-contact. It's easier to start doing this more often if taken step by small step. My eye contact over time in conversations increased over the span of a few months when I started focusing on just one of the other person's eyes at a time.

4. Keep that smart phone away. Darnit! Put that phone down while listening unless you need to check something or write something down as a part of the conversation.

5. Summarize what was said. Summarize what someone just said –right back to them– makes it a lot easier to make sure you understand.

6. Ask instead of trying to mind-read. That impulse to assume and mind-read: Stop that and start being curious and ask open-ended questions. Going for this kind of question instead requires something other than Yes or No.

7. Get some fresh air and/or exercise. Few things make it so hard to follow along in a conversation as a tired and foggy head. Two things that can keep that energy and mental clarity up are: a walk outside to get some exercise and fresh air.

8. When you listen, just listen. Interruptions or jumping in with solutions is not a great idea. This can be a hard one in my experience). Be present in the moment and listen fully to what the other person has to say and let them speak until the entire message is said. Sometimes that's all that's needed.

9. Be honest about your current limitations. Feeling very tired or stressed or too rushed? Let the other person know. It is better for the both of you to be honest and to continue the conversation later than try to fake undivided attention or to try to keep the listening up when you honestly just can't. Make a date to continue.

10. Share what you have done in a similar situation. When asked for advice while listening or when it seems appropriate – (not when the other person just needs to vent and get things out) – share what you have done in a similar situation and what worked well for you. That gives a lot more weight to your input than just random advice or opinions about what you think could work.

New Construction Home Inspections

Prior to becoming a home inspector I spent over 10 years working as a project manager for new construction homes. I know the pressure a builder can feel to complete the project on time. I also saw the stress a new build can put on a buyer.

There's no question that the housing market in our area is hot. It's great to see the increase of new construction, but in today's market, where builders are building as fast as possible to keep up with demand, pressure and stress is often amplified.

A home inspection prior to closing helps ease some of a buyer's concerns. It's a professional opinion of a third party. The report summarizes and


quantifies issues and puts to sleep a buyer's worry of the unknown.

A new construction home inspection gives a builder a final punch list of items to complete prior to occupancy.

Typically the listed items are minor, but issues of consequence are occasionally found, including;

- No attic ventilation
- Missing insulation
- Water leaking from walls, ceilings
- Outlets not working

Over the years, I have heard people say there isn't radon in new construction, which just isn't true. It does not matter if the home is 1 or 100 years old – radon gets into houses. I recently completed a radon test on a newly constructed house with a passive system installed, and the test came in



over 11.0 picocuries. That level is significant enough for mitigation.

Buying a newly built home is often an individual's largest investment of their life. Considering the home's price, closing costs, and other expenses associated with purchase, the fee for a home inspection is well worth the buyer's peace of mind and a sense of a more complete product.





Can you spot the difference?

There's a difference between the keyboxes pictured to the right. Yes, one is clean and one is dirty, but there is another *suBTLE* difference to pay attention to.

Any keybox that does not say LE is an outdated keybox. The outdated keyboxes were not compatible with iPhones and, as a result, many agents had to use a special fob.

In 2016 OABR hosted a keybox exchange for agents to update their boxes to the new BTLE's. These new keyboxes are compatible with iPhones and have a much higher performance rate. While old BT keyboxes may still work for some Android users, it is recommended that agents update their boxes and purchase the new BTLE's.

Almost 2 years have passed since the exchange, but there are a still a high number of outdated BT keyboxes out in the Omaha area. We want every agent to have full access to your listings and we also want to be sure these outdated boxes are properly disposed of. If you are one of the agents with an outdated box, you are encouraged to think green and bring them into OABR to be recycled. For every old keybox you bring in, we will enter you in for a chance to win a current BTLE keybox for free!
